## Camp Schedule

The McMurry Band Camp schedule and rules are designed to give all campers a fun, educational, and safe experience. Students are expected to abide by camp rules at all times.

### Sunday, July 12 – Registration and Introductory Activities

1:00 – 3:00 p.m. Welcome to camp! Please do the following in the order indicated:

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Register for camp in the Bynum Band Hall Lobby.</li> <li>2. Check-in at the dorms and drop off your luggage. <i>Do not unpack yet.</i> There will be time for this later.</li> <li>3. <b>High School Band, Middle School Band, and Drum Majors</b> return to the Bynum Band Hall with your instrument for auditions. Audition room numbers will be posted. After your audition, report to the Mabee Room in the Campus Center and wait there until the camp meeting.</li> <li>4. <b>Colorguard and Twirling</b> campers report to the Mabee Room in the Campus Center and wait there until the camp meeting.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Register for camp in the Bynum Band Hall Lobby.</li> <li>2. <b>High School Band, Middle School Band, and Drum Majors</b> audition for band placement at the Bynum Band Hall. Audition room numbers will be posted. After your audition, report to the Mabee Room in the Campus Center and wait there until the camp meeting.</li> <li>3. <b>Colorguard and Twirling</b> campers report directly to the Mabee Room in the Campus Center and wait there until the camp meeting.</li> </ol>

4:00 p.m. All-camp meeting (mandatory for all campers) in the Mabee Room in the Campus Center

5:00 p.m.

- Colorguard and Twirling campers meet with instructional staff for an initial skill evaluation. Bring your equipment and wear rehearsal attire to this meeting.
- Day Campers are free to go home for the evening after the meeting.
- Residential campers for Middle School Band, High School Band, and Drum Major camps may return to dorm rooms to unpack.

**Monday – Friday, July 13 - 17**

Camp classes and rehearsals begin at 9:00 a.m. and end promptly at 5:00 p.m. Day campers can be dropped off at the Bynum Band Hall in the mornings, and should be picked up in the same location by 5:30 p.m. each day. Additional evening activities are required for residential campers. Evening activities will also be open to Day Campers.

- 1:30 – 4:30 Band/Elective II

- 7:30 Scheduled Camp Social Activity (required)

**Saturday, July 18**

Dress for the day is your camp shirt (to be distributed on Friday, July 17th), shorts or jeans, and tennis shoes. You should wear this for the picture and during your performance.

- 8:00 – 8:45 a.m. – Residential campers check out of dorms and turn in your keys before you go eat breakfast.
- 9:00 a.m. - All campers assemble at Kimbrell Arena in the Hunt Physical Education Center for the camp picture.
- 9:30 – Warm-up time for all groups. Bands - inside Kimbrell Arena, Colorguard and Twirling - outside.
- 10:00 a.m. – Outdoor performances by the All-day Colorguard and Twirling groups
- 10:30 – Concert inside Kimbrell Arena

Patches will be distributed to all campers at the conclusion of the concert (between 11:30 and noon). You have to stay to get your patch. They will not be distributed early!
